

Target Audience






Location

Things to Consider

- Who can access it?
- Does it cost?
- Is it in a location that is safe and people can find?
- What is the capacity that it holds?
- Is there availability for expansion and ad on's?





Timing

Timing depends on the area where the activity will be hosted


Example: Patient profile


Maggie is an 86 year old female living with vascular dementia - admitted with dehydration, UTI, and a fall at home.

- PMHx: vascular dementia, stroke 2016 (mild left U/E weakness), glaucoma, diabetes, and arthritis.
- Medications: Antihypertensive, Diuretic, Dilaudid, and numerous over the counter medications. She has a hematoma to left side of face with minor skin tears to her arms. She typically uses a 4ww to mobilize and lives in Assisted Living.

Suggested IdeasClinical Setting


- Cluttered path
- Spill on floor
- Cords
- Lighting to bright or to low
- Table far away from bed
- Bed at a high awkward height
- Brake not on equipment and/ or table or bed
- Sheets or blanket hanging off the bed loosely






For Home Setting

- Scatter rugs
- Pet toys
- Things set in high places out of reach
- Furniture that is unsteady
- Glare from windows
- Bed skirts hanging on the ground

Once you have identified the risk factors, take your sheet to Admin to collect your reward for solving the case.




